Please be advised Commodity Forwarders policy regarding handling of frozen products during transit when shipped in our Young Brothers Consolidation Program via chilled containers.

This form will confirm that you have been made aware that your frozen shipment will be transported in a chilled container set at 32-36 degrees while in transit. During this transit Commodity Forwarders recommends you purchase additional services of insulation and dry ice to help maintain a frozen temperature and minimize potential product deterioration issues. While there are packaging materials available to us that will allow us to minimize the temperature fluctuation in transit, these materials will not guarantee the arrival of your product in a frozen state since we are not utilizing a frozen container and as such we cannot assume liability for arrival temperature for goods of this nature for any reason. If you wish to ship without the use of dry ice or insulation etc. we will honor your request however will require a release of liability be completed prior to shipping.

We will file a claim with the CFI under the following circumstances only:

- 1) Product was damaged physically in transit such as crushing
- 2) Product shortage.

In the event a claim is required to be filed with CFI services and freight charges are to be paid in full within our 30 day payment terms.
